P7 Transition to Queensferry High School

We would be delighted to invite you to the first information evening at the High School on **Tuesday 28th February at 7pm**. This meeting will take place in the school Assembly Hall. There will be presentations from Senior staff in school and from some of our pupils. This is a great opportunity for us to welcome you to the high school and to share information about the transition of your child from primary to secondary school. There will also be an opportunity for a question and answer session.

I have highlighted other key dates below:

20th, 21st, 22nd June: Pupils will attend a 3 day induction to life at the High School. Pupils will sample a variety of subjects during their 3 day visit to the High School. Third year prefects will escort each group to and from each lesson. This is a fantastic opportunity for your child to experience high school life, meet their teachers, develop new friendships and become familiar with their new surroundings in preparation for starting high school in August.
